Additional Costs to Students

Incidental expenses will be charged to students for the provision of text books, manuals or other physical equipment that is retained by the student on completion of training. These charges will be at actual cost to Australian Agricultural Training.

Australian Agricultural Training will provide where possible text books and manuals by electronic form. If the student wishes to have a hard copy they can purchase it.

In the Certificate IV Wool Classing students are required to obtain the current AWEX Code of Practice \$20 and First Aid resources \$50.

In Certificate III Agriculture students are required to obtain First Aid resources \$50. These can be purchased from AAT.

Australian Agricultural Training does not impose levies for wool, fuel or paper to students undertaking full qualifications.

Terms and Conditions

Students will be issued with a tax invoice and a statement of fees by Australian Agricultural Training Pty Ltd. Fees are payable when a learner has received a confirmation of enrolment. The initial fee payment must be made prior to commencing training or within 5 days of receiving an invoice from Australian Agricultural Training. Australian Agricultural Training may discontinue training if fees are not paid in accordance with the agreed fee schedule. The current fees and charges for Australian Agricultural Training are published within the current schedule of fees and charges.

Payment options are available (cheque, direct credit, credit card). Students may request in writing to the CEO to pay their fees under a payment plan ie (weekly monthly repayments). A receipt will be issued once payment is received.

Limiting Fees Being Paid in Advance

Australian Agricultural Training acknowledges that it has a responsibility under the Standards for Registered Training Organisations to limit the fees paid by learners in advance of their training and assessment services being delivered. To meet our responsibilities Australian Agricultural Training may accept payment of no more than \$1,500 from each learner prior to the commencement of the course. This requirement only applies when the payment for the fees are being made directly by an individual that falls under the protection of Australian Consumer Law.

Refunds Policy

The following refund policy will apply:

- Learners, who give notice to cancel their enrolment **10 business days** or more prior to the commencement of a program, will be entitled to a full refund of fees paid.
- Learners who give notice to cancel their enrolment **9 business days** or less prior to the commencement of a program will be entitled to a 75% refund of fees paid. The amount retained (25%) by Australian Agricultural Training is required to cover the costs of staff and resources which will have already been committed based on the learners initial intention to undertake the training.

Learners who cancel their enrolment after a training program has commenced will not be entitled to a refund of fees of any fees paid in advance. An exception to this policy is where Australian Agricultural Training fails to fulfil its service agreement and fees are refunded under our guarantee to clients.

Re-issue of Certificates

Australian Agricultural Training acknowledges the requirement to provide past and present learners with re-issued qualifications and statements of attainment when required. Australian Agricultural Training charges a \$65 fee for reissue of Qualifications or Statements of Attainments.
